DIVERSEcity Community Resources Society is accepting applications to the **Funke Ilumoka Bursary for 2018-2019**.

The \$500 bursary has been created in memory of Funke Ilumoka — a respected, long-term employee and Community Kitchen Coordinator in DIVERSEcity’s Food Security Program. DIVERSEcity wishes to honour Funke’s memory and acknowledge her commitment and contributions to the newcomers she guided in the program over the years.

DIVERSEcity’s Funke Ilumoka Bursary will be awarded to an exceptional newcomer in British Columbia who has demonstrated that they have:

1. Enhanced their work opportunities through the development of food related skills, OR
2. enrolled in an educational program to pursue their food related career goal, OR
3. been a champion of food security issues in the community.

The applications will be reviewed by a Selection Committee made up of DIVERSEcity managers and representatives of other community service providers supporting food security in the community.

1. Please note that the Bursary Award recipient will be asked to attend the presentation ceremony to be held at DIVERSEcity's Annual General Meeting on **Wednesday, September 25, 2019 (4 – 6 pm)**. The recipient may invite family/guests.
2. Please type responses directly onto the Application Form, respecting the response limits provided for each question.
3. You may nominate yourself or someone else. The “Applicant” refers to the person nominating themselves for the Bursary. The “Nominator” refers to the person who is nominating someone else. Please identify the person you want us to communicate with regarding the application (referred to as the “Contact Person”).
4. Save the completed application file using the Name of the Applicant.
5. E-mail the completed application form as an attachment to: mroman@dcrs.ca by the deadline of **4:30pm on Friday, August 16, 2019**.
6. Upon receiving your application, we will send an e-mail confirmation that we have successfully received your application.
7. You will be notified of the Selection Committee's decision by **Tuesday, August 27, 2019**.
