DIVERSEcity Community Resources Society is now accepting applications for the **Maria Celaje Bursary for 2018-2019**.

The \$500 bursary was created in memory of Maria Celaje — a respected, long-term employee and Workplace Facilitator in DIVERSEcity’s Future Leaders Program. DIVERSEcity wishes to honour Maria’s memory and acknowledge her commitment and contributions to the immigrant youth she guided in the program over the years.

DIVERSEcity’s Maria Celaje Bursary will be awarded to an exceptional young adult immigrant between the ages of 19 and 30 who has demonstrated that they have:

1. Enhanced their work opportunities through the development of specific skills
2. Transitioned successfully into employment
3. Enrolled in an educational upgrading program to pursue their career goal
4. Have been associated with DIVERSEcity services

The applications will be reviewed by a Selection Committee made up of DIVERSEcity managers and representatives other community service providers supporting immigrant youth and their economic integration.

1. Please note that the Bursary Award recipient will be asked to attend the presentation ceremony to be held at DIVERSEcity's Annual General Meeting on **Wednesday, September 25, 2019 (4 – 6 pm)**. The recipient may invite family/guests.
2. Please type responses directly onto the Application Form, respecting the response limits provided for each question
3. You may nominate yourself or someone else. The “Applicant” refers to the person nominating themselves for the Bursary. The “Nominator” refers to the person who is nominating someone else. Please identify the person you want us to communicate with regarding the application (referred to as the “Contact Person”).
4. Save the completed application using the name of the Applicant.
5. Email the completed application form as an attachment to: vjoshi@dcrs.ca by the deadline of **4:30 pm Friday, August 23, 2019**.
6. Upon receiving your application, we will send an email confirmation that we have successfully received your application.
7. You will be notified of the Selection Committee's decision by **Tuesday, September 3, 2019**.
