

We are currently recruiting for the role of **Cleaner, Seniors Housekeeping – Independent Contractor** for a freelance- on call position for the Better at Home Program to fulfill client's needs of Seniors housekeeping in Surrey. Services will be provided at the client's residence and at designated times. The goal of the Better at Home Program is to provide key services to seniors that will help them to live independently at their homes for as long as possible.

The Seniors Housekeeping Service connects seniors in the Surrey area with housekeepers who have the skills and availability to help them with daily living chores such as light housecleaning, and laundry support. The Better At Home Seniors Housekeeping Service is strictly a non-medical home support service. The specific tasks that are included in the Better At Home Seniors Housekeeping Service are outlined on the Service list on the assessment form. Better At Home is not responsible for any repercussions that happen as a result of a housekeeper performing tasks that are not included in the service list.

The successful candidates will have: Strong interpersonal, and verbal communications skills. A high school diploma at minimum. Previous experience in contracted cleaning. The ability to speak English. Fluency in spoken Punjabi, Hindi, Mandarin, Arabic and Korean is an asset. A desire to support seniors and understanding of seniors needs is highly desirable. Candidates must be authorized to work in Canada, and have ability to provide own transportation to attend assignments. Candidates must be available to work in the Surrey Area.

The Cleaner, Seniors Housekeeping – Independent Contractor will also participate in mandatory orientation and training, including ongoing check ins with Program Coordinators. The Cleaner is responsible for scheduling appointments directly with clients after assignment by the Program Coordinator.

A Criminal Record Check is a requirement of employment.
